RESOLUTION APPROVING COUNTY POLICY CONCERNING OPEN RECORDS
REQUESTS

Resolution

WHEREAS, Adams County is a governmental entity which is required to comply with the Colorado Open Records Act ("CORA"), C.R.S. §§ 24-72-201 et seq.; and,

WHEREAS, Adams County is committed to the principle of open, transparent, and accessible government; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized by CORA to develop rules governing the inspection of public records and charge a reasonable fee for copies, printouts, and photographs, along with research and retrieval activities, made at the request of an individual or entity; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to adopt a new County Policy on Open Records Requests, which is incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners intends for this Policy to supersede and replace all prior policies, rules or regulations with respect to responding to requests for public records and assessing charges for the production of public records.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado that the County Policy on Open Records Requests, which is incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the effective date of this policy is immediate upon approval.
