BACKGROUND:

Adams County (the “County”) was approached by the property owner to the east of the Commerce City, Fleet and Public Works buildings, Allied Waste Transportation Inc. (“Allied”), regarding the gap in the fence along the property line. This work required a temporary construction easement and right of entry from Allied which was previously approved by the Board under Resolution 2023-505. Allied has requested a permanent Fence Easement for the purpose of access, operating, maintaining, replacing, enlarging, reconstructing, improving, inspecting, repairing, grading the area around the fence and fence gate, and removing such fence and fence gate and appurtenances thereto as may from time to time be required on, over, across, and through the following described land
