RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE COLORADO PARKS AND WILDLIFE  
NON-MOTORIZED TRAILS GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE RIVERDALE BLUFFS  
OPEN SPACE

Resolution 2024-

WHEREAS, the Colorado Parks and Wildlife Non-Motorized Trails Grant is intended to support projects that improve outdoor recreation opportunities including trail construction, maintenance, planning, support, and stewardship, while protecting wildlife, habitat, and cultural resources; and,

WHEREAS, Adams County Parks, Open Space, and Cultural Arts has applied for supporting funds of \$250,000 from the Non-Motorized Trails Grant Program for the Riverdale Bluffs Open Space Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Riverdale Bluffs Open Space Project will formalize a robust trail network which will enhance regional connectivity, provide safe roadway crossings, increase recreation opportunities, and revitalize the natural habitat; and,

WHEREAS, the Riverdale Bluffs Open Space property will remain under Adams County ownership for a minimum of 25 years; and,

WHEREAS, the Riverdale Bluffs Open Space property will be monitored and maintained by Adams County Parks, Open Space, and Cultural Arts Operations Team and the Adams County Park Rangers Service who will protect and upkeep restoration, concrete, fencing, trails, and other enhancements as needed; and,

WHEREAS, the Adams County Board of County Commissioners recognizes the financial and legal obligations associated with the project, including, but not limited to, ongoing maintenance and operations expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Adams, State of Colorado, supports the Colorado Parks and Wildlife Non-Motorized Trails Grant application for the Riverdale Bluffs Open Space, including the project's completion and associated maintenance expenses.
