

**RESOLUTION RATIFYING APPROVAL OF STATE OF COLORADO
INTERGOVERNMENTAL GRANT AGREEMENT FOR SLFRF**

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado created a grant process for Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (“SLFRF”) program; and,

WHEREAS, the 17th Judicial District Attorney’s Office applied for a SLFRF grant through the State of Colorado to support victim’s services at the District Attorney’s Office; and,

WHEREAS, the State awarded funds to Adams County for purposes of funding victim’s services at the District Attorney’s Office; and,

WHEREAS, on December 3, 2022, District Attorney Brian Mason signed an Intergovernmental Grant Agreement for receipt of the victim’s services funds; and,

WHEREAS, the grant recipient in the Agreement was Adams County and required signature and approval from the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, the funds were received for use by the District Attorney’s Office and were used appropriately within the scope of the grant award; and,

WHEREAS, the State has asked that Adams County correct the signature approval for the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, Adams County now wishes to formally ratify the approval of the State of Colorado Intergovernmental Grant Agreement for SLFRF as previously signed by the District Attorney on December 3, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that the State of Colorado Intergovernmental Grant Agreement for SLFRF, a copy of which is attached, is hereby ratified and approved.
